1.Buy Kidney vetch

Kidney vetch has small clusters of pale yellow flowers. Sometimes the flowers may also be red or orange. In the wild, Kidney vetch can be found on roadsides, coastal areas and grassland. In the garden, it is ideal in a bee and butterfly border or rockery preferring a light, well-drained soil.

Great for containers too.

2.Buy Red clover

Red clover will flower for several months. Fabulous in grassland, meadow or at the front of a border. It is great for attracting Bumble bees through the Summer, and is also ideal to plant in containers. The plants love a sunny spot with well drained soil.

3.Buy Ox eye daisy

Ox eye daisy looks great naturalised into grassland with buttercups, knapweed and other meadow flowers or is amazing in flower beds. It is a real sun lover, and will survive in many soil types to return year after year.

4.Buy Birdsfoot trefoil

Birdsfoot trefoil is a plant for nectar and caterpillar food. It is low growing with beautiful yellow flowers. which change to orange as they mature. It will grow in a range of soil types and is ideal to grow in a garden lawn, grassland, meadow or patio container.

5.Buy Wild marjoram

Wild marjoram flowers from mid summer with clusters of pale lilac blooms. The flowers can last well into the Autumn and still attract pollinators. Lovely in a cottage garden or a container in sun/part shade. It prefers a well drained soil.
